ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS

- Assists in coordinating pickups and deliveries
- Pickup donations from distributors
- Loads and Unloads deliveries and pickups
- Assists in the recruitment of distributors and partners
- Delivers resources to One More Child campuses and sites
- Ensures regular maintenance, cleanings, and upkeep of warehouse vehicles
- Works with the Volunteer Coordinator in providing excellent volunteer experiences in the warehouse
- Oversees safe food storage practices in the Harold Clark Simmons Compassion Center
- When not driving, works with warehouse coordinator on warehouse projects
- Perform other duties as assigned
