Dominican Republic

In partnership with the Dominican Republic government, we are constructing a community that includes nearly 100 single-family homes, a community transformation center and a church plant. This community transformation center serves as a place where children and families can build positive life-long relationships, take part in life-changing ministry and have access to after-school programs.

Uganda

According to the International Fund for Agricultural Development, 84 percent of Ugandans live in rural areas where children lack access to proper nutrition, education and medical care. We built a medical clinic and three school buildings at Genesis Primary School and lives are being changed because of educational resources, nutritious food and spiritual support.

Nicaragua

We minister at a senior living center as well as meet the physical and spiritual needs of children in Managua. Thousands of children live in high poverty neighborhoods around the capital city, and we help address their physical and spiritual hunger with means and Christian fellowship provided at a local church.

Colombia

Nearly one-third of Colombians live in poverty. To provide hope for those in need we work in schools, support medical clinics and work with a local church in Villeta, where we meet the physical and spiritual needs of children.

Costa Rica

We work with two local feeding programs and we work with child victims of sex trafficking to provide them with a safe place to live and opportunities to find restoration and self worth as they try to recover from the emotional and physical trauma of being used and deceived.

Latvia

Through a partnership with a local government agency, we lead a summer camp for children just outside the capital city of Riga. This outreach provides an opportunity to share Christ's love with children who may have never experienced real love and care before.

Tanzania

At the Compassion House, we provide a safe haven to orphans through a holistic care model. We provide life-changing meals at a neighboring orphanage that is home to young children and teenagers who are desperate to have their basic needs met.

Guatemala

According to UNICEF, there are more than 370,000 orphans in Guatemala and the chronic malnutrition rate for children under five years old is 50 percent, the fourth highest in the world. In 2008, we began helping meet the incredible needs of many of these precious children at the Malnutrition Center in San Juan by providing specialized meal plans, medical and dental care for children who live onsite plus food baskets for families in the community and more.

Romania

Post-communist Romania is a country that is home to many driven individuals working toward political and social progress. We have a ministry partnership in Oradea, Romania that feeds and engages children in gypsy villages, improves the lives of children at a local orphanage, interacts with children in foster care and works with abandoned babies in a local hospital.

South Africa

Many communities that continue to recover from the apartheid era in this country have substandard housing, limited infrastructure and too few schools and job opportunities. We provide Christ-centered feeding programs that offer children healthy meals and spiritual nourishment they desperately need.

Kenya

In Naivasha, Kenya, the old town jail has been restored to serve as a safe house for children in emergency situations. We fund a feeding program that ensures hot meals on a daily basis for the children, who are trying to find respite in the midst of trauma. Through a local partnership, mission teams work with children and families in impoverished rural Kenya.

Jamaica

We are coordinating and implementing an intensive tutoring program for students, focused on literacy and math. This program ensures more students are prepared to pass their grade-six achievement test, which is required to enroll in high school in Jamaica. We are also helping send children to summer camp at the Jamaican Baptist Union Conference Center.

Haiti

In 2010, Haiti was devastated by a powerful earthquake, leaving many children without a family, shelter or hope. We partner with organizations that operate orphanages in Haiti to make an impact in the lives of these children. Our role is to assist the organizations with their feeding programs that ensure children have adequate nutrition on a daily basis.
